A ground breaking ceremony was held on October 16 to commemorate this important milestone. As a safety precaution, the ground breaking ceremony did not include a live audience and participation was kept to campaign and CHPC leadership. 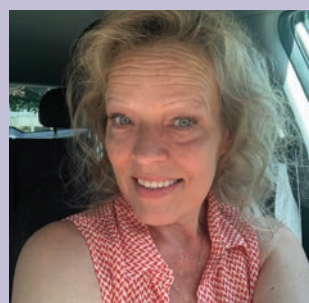

After a little more than a year since the Our House Campaign began, CHPC campaign staff and volunteers have raised nearly \$1.7 million, about 80% of the campaign goal. The Star’s recent legacy gift boosted the fund-raising effort and provided renewed momentum as the Campaign enters the holiday season.

“It has been a privilege for Bert and me to be part of the Our House Campaign to build a hospice residence,” said Mary Rappole. “Generosity combined with compassion are evident in Chautauqua County. People want to be part of this community project.”

Campaign and CHPC leadership are grateful to area foundations that provided early support during the quiet phase. The Lenna Foundation, Carnahan-Jackson Foundation, Jessie Smith Darrah Fund, Holmberg Foundation, Chautauqua Region Community Foundation and the First Niagara/KeyBank Foundations

gave the campaign initial success and legitimacy. Private donations soon followed when the campaign entered its public phase in late Spring. Some donations came from people who were asked to give by campaign volunteers, while others arrived because the need for a hospice house is so important.

Reflecting on the year of fund raising that has gotten the Campaign to within striking distance of its goal, Co-Chair Bert Rappole finds great satisfaction in leading the charge. “Palliative and Hospice care have always had special meaning to me as a physician,” he said. “During this campaign I have been overwhelmed by the caring concern of members of our community who, after the public announcement, spontaneously made substantial donations to support the building of the Hospice House.”

In addition to the naming of the residence, other naming gifts have been received. Tyler and Carolyn Swanson's gift will allow the naming of the family kitchen in memory of Gilbert and Florence Swanson. The deck will be named in memory of Verna and Dick Jackson thanks to Karen Goodell's 60-60-60 fundraising effort (see inset on page 6). Other naming opportunities are still available for the great room, bedrooms and fireplace. Contact a campaign volunteer or the CHPC offices for more information.

Having reached 80% of the campaign goal means there is still 20% or nearly \$465,000 to be raised. This is a sizable figure and far exceeds any amount raised by CHPC in an ordinary year. Keeping the community updated and engaged and informed about the project will be critical to reaching the goal.

"There will be dust, noise and commotion throughout the Spring as construction progresses," said Shauna Anderson. "This should create some excitement and engagement."

Construction is expected to be completed by June 2021 with operations commencing soon thereafter. In the meantime, the Our House Campaign

Advance Care Planning: Now More Than Ever

THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC HAS BROUGHT INTO FOCUS the importance of planning for our care when we become incapacitated. As the crisis unfolded to our disbelief, and as parts of this country are now experiencing a surge in infections, we are witnessing the worst possible outcomes. Loved ones are prevented from visiting sickened family members. Patients are being triaged for ventilators which are in short supply. Emergency room physicians are getting crash courses in palliative medicine as they are forced into very difficult conversations with patients and families.

Despite these being the most difficult of times, the attention the pandemic has focused on end-of-life decisions will have a beneficial impact on our planning. If ever there was a time to consider healthcare proxies and things that matter most to us, the time is now.

Advance care planning encompasses the conversations and documentation that assure our wishes are honored when we are unable to make our own healthcare decisions. It requires thoughtful reflection and the participation of those close to you.

The Resources section of the CHPC website has links to helpful information including downloadable forms. In addition, two reputable organizations linked on our site offer excellent resources: Aging With Dignity and The Conversation Project.

If the holiday season will bring your loved ones together, consider using this opportunity to document your concerns and share them with your loved ones.

CHPC Chosen for Alpha Test

CHPC is one of only 20 hospice providers to be chosen by the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) to participate in the alpha testing phase of development of the Hospice Outcomes & Patient Evaluation (HOPE) assessment.

The HOPE assessment is important to developing a set of hospice quality measures to improve outcomes for patients, their families and providers while also reducing burden on providers and clinicians. CHPC insights and feedback will provide CMS with the necessary information to further develop the HOPE assessment and its guidance in preparation for national beta testing.

"Participating in this alpha testing will allow CHPC to understand the HOPE assessment early in the process and make for a smooth transition when implementation begins," said Tom Summerville, VP of Clinical Services.

Memorial Tree Lighting Ceremony Scheduled for Saturday, December 5th at 6pm

Each holiday season Chautauqua Hospice & Palliative Care presents our Light A Life Memorial as a tribute to loved ones who have passed. This is a time of remembrance, not just for the families we have served, but for all community members regardless of whether or not we cared for their loved one.

There are several changes from previous years. The important changes include the LAL Service being streamed live online only (no in-person attendance), and ornament orders will only be available online.

Memorial Service and Tree Lighting Ceremony

On Saturday, December 5th at 6pm we will hold our Light A Life Memorial Service and Tree Lighting Ceremony at Chautauqua Hospice and Palliative Care. This year's service will only be streamed online, in consideration of Covid-19 restrictions. The video link will be available on our Facebook page and the recording will be available on our website after the service. Our Memorial Tree and Light Towers will be illuminated at the online service.

Loved ones' names will be included in the Event Program and Light Towers. CHPC patients who have passed in the last year will be included automatically. Anyone can memorialize a loved one and have their name included if an ornament is purchased in their memory or if their name is submitted to us on the LAL event page of our website. Any community member can be included, regardless of whether or not they were cared for by CHPC. LAL programs will be available for download off the CHPC website at www.chpc.care.

Holiday Ornaments

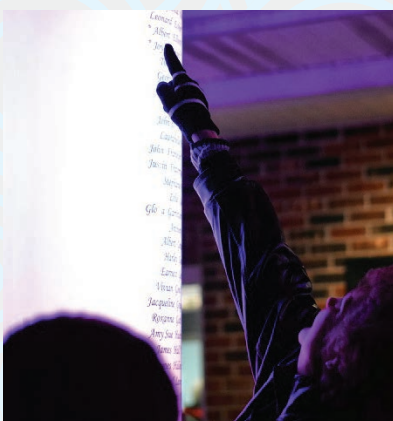
